

Progress Through Partnership

William Carey, the father of modern missions said, "Expect great things from God. Attempt great things for God." We have discovered that those great things are often realized through key partnerships. Such was the case in our recent Spring Impact construction and outreach projects.

The goals were ambitious: advance the construction at *Instituto Bíblico Bethel* (IBB), stimulate ministerial formation among Bible school students, and encourage evangelism efforts in the Yucatán. The challenges were real--physical, financial, and spiritual.

Nevertheless, the needs



were met when pivotal partners responded. Donors provided funds to purchase building materials, Chi Alpha (XA): University of Virginia and American University provided the willingness, labor, and stamina for the work, and local Bible school students and pastors provided planning, support, and oversight.
