pioneer pastor in the northern region of the Yucatán who is starting congregations in previously unreached areas.

In the south, Rangel
Vazquez, one of my former
students, is opening a
remote section of Tzucacab
near the border of Quintana
Roo. In Tigre Grande, he's been
successful in restarting a work

that had been lost due to flooding, while a new work in Polhuacxil has grown to 15 people!

Through Rangel, Miriam, and Felipe, we see the mission being carried out and the vision being fulfilled. Thanks for your help in sending us to join these and recruit others like them!
