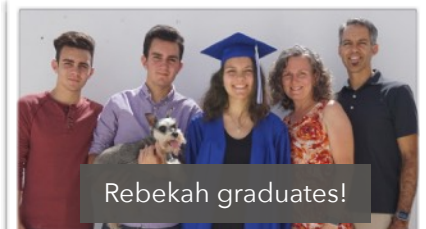
However as I was nominated and the vote overwhelming turned in our favor, the pieces of the puzzle fell into place: as
