Each year we join with teams from the US to collaborate on projects here in Mexico that would be difficult to complete without outside help. This past week, we received a 6 member team from Richmond Chi Alpha (RVXA) to raise a roof for Bethel Assembly (above).

This church, in the economically depressed area of Kopte, is still recovering from the devastation of Hurricane Isidore, whose high winds and floods wiped out all but a portion of the rear wall. RVXA was able to provide funds to purchase the

galvanized metal roofing needed to complete the work and join with church members to put those materiales in place. The funds they invested, their time and physical labor, as well as their ministry among the children

of the village served as an infusion of hope for the needy church, which promised to continue where the team had left off.

Later this month, we will join with missionary Nicky Rider to receive a team from Rolla First

Assembly, which will work in Tekax to advance the construction of a church and training center for the predominantly Maya population of the region.
